Car batteries, nickel cadmium rechargeable and button type mercury batteries and fluorescent bulbs are also accepted during normal hours.

NOT ACCEPTED: Demolition materials or wood waste, household garbage, hazardous wastes - including paint, pesticides or chemicals. Cass County will collect household hazardous waste and electronics (No Businesses) at this location on Thursday, August 8th from 1:00 to 3:00.

Assistance will be available to help you unload and sort your items. Materials accepted ONLY from Crooked Lake or Beulah Township residents- BE PREPARED TO PROVE RESIDENCY!

Good, useable furniture and appliances can be redistributed through the Cass County Materials Exchange Program (MATEX) to those in need. These items can be dropped off at the Pine River Transfer Station, or call 218-547-7428 for more information.
